

## TOWN OF INOLA

### TOWN BOARD OF TRUSTEES REGULAR MEETING APRIL 9, 2001

The Inola Town Board of Trustees met in regular session Monday, April 9, 2001. The meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m. by Mayor Tommie Grigg. Members present were Erin Oquin, Duane Helling and Tommie Grigg. Becky Cox was also present. Lonnie Chasteen and Wilma Cargill were absent.

A motion was made by Erin Oquin to approve the March 26, 2001 meeting minutes as presented with a change on page 2 – the Fire Dept. storage building cost should be changed from \$1,800.00 to \$18,000.00. Duane Helling 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Voting yes were Erin, Duane and Tommie.

There was no new business and no communications from the floor.

Mayor Grigg advised Kenny Schwab, FHC, recommends for the Town Board to approve the Stormwater Plan from the school with the stipulation that the drawings reflect the new calculations. A motion was made by Erin Oquin to approve the Inola Public School Stormwater Plan provided that the drawings will reflect the new calculations and upon receipt and approval from the Town's Engineer. The motion was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Duane Helling. Voting yes were Erin, Duane and Tommie.

There was no action on the internet user policy at this time.

Erin Oquin made a motion to appoint Gary Rosbrugh as the plumbing inspector for the Town 2<sup>nd</sup> by Duane Helling. Voting yes were Erin, Duane and Tommie.

Approval of the Code Book was tabled.

Board Members discussed and reviewed the requests from the Department of Labor. Gene Cooksey advised that the signs are done and he needs to drag the fan outside. Police Chief, Les Wilmott, took care of the fire extinguishers. Gene will go over the list with Becky and give an update of what else needs to be done and this item will be on the next agenda.

Tommie informed Board Members that Jon Tilley will be helping us with the FEMA paperwork. He will also follow up on all the money we receive from them.

Tommie has checked with Chief Kramer about getting the inmates back to do some more work around town. There are some small piles of debris that the inmates left on school property and some other areas that need to be cleaned up.

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Jim Summerlin has advised the Board to form a committee to meet with Chris Veltema to resolve the issue of the items he needs to return to the Town. A letter will be sent first and then the committee will meet with Mr. Veltema. A motion was made by Erin Oquin for Tommie Grigg and Duane Helling to be the committee members that will meet with Chris Veltema to retrieve the items belonging to the Town and to remove any of his computer programs to return to him. Tommie Grigg 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Voting yes were Erin, Duane and Tommie.

A motion to go into PWA was made by Erin Oquin at 6:47 p.m. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Duane Helling. Voting yes were Erin, Duane and Tommie.

Back in regular session at 7:01 p.m.

Under Mayor's comments, Mayor Grigg wanted to thank Kenneth Crutchfield for the mile of asphalt that was just laid. He has done a great job as County Commissioner and Inola appreciates him. Gorge Reese and Gene Cooksey identified the streets that were in the greatest need of repair – C St. SW, A St. SW and 1<sup>st</sup> St. SE.

A special meeting will be held Monday, April 16, 2001 at 7:30 p.m. to swear in new Board Members and reaffirm committee members.

George Reese resigned effective today, April 9<sup>th</sup>. Due to some personal problems, he is moving back to Georgia. He was offered his old job back at the City of Tybee Island. We need to run an ad in the Inola and Claremore papers and maybe the OML for a General Maintenance Employee, starting at \$9.50 per hour. Applications need to be turned in to Town Hall by 5 p.m. on April 25, 2001. The Board will review the applications at the April 30, 2001 meeting as well as take a look at Gene's wages. Board Members may also consider the part-time employment of Janet Donnelly. Janet is presently doing our water & wastewater tests, on a contract labor basis, which typically runs around \$1,100.00 per month.

Vahik Abovian, Jodee Construction, will start on the sewer line replacement project possibly tomorrow or Wednesday.

A motion to approve the purchase orders for payment with the exception of PO 2033 – Black Beauty roof patching – ordered by Chris Veltema – 2<sup>nd</sup> by Duane Helling. (Becky will check on the PO in question and report back). Voting yes were Erin, Duane and Tommie.

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Duane Helling made a motion to adjourn at 7:21 p.m. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Erin Oquin. Voting yes were Erin, Duane and Tommie.
