

**Town of Inola Regular Board of Trustees Meeting
May 31, 2022**

The Inola Town Board of Trustees assembled at 6:00 p.m. on May 31, 2021 at the Town Hall located at 900 James Ct., Inola, Ok. Mayor Larry Grigg called the Town Trustee meeting to order and requested that roll be called by the Town Clerk. Answering to roll call were Trent Bynum, Larry Grigg, Dan Corle, and Darlene Shear. 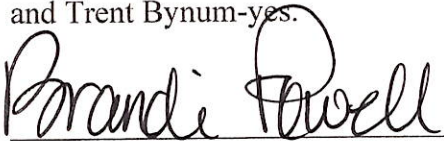

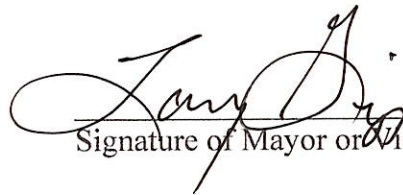
MAYOR'S COMMENTS: Dan wanted to thank Billy and Brian for all their hard work in getting Inola Grants.
