TOWN BOARD OF TRUSTEES REGULAR MEETING NOVEMBER 25, 2002

The Inola Town Board of Trustees met in regular session Monday, November 25, 2002. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tommie Grigg at 7:00 p.m. Members present were Glennie Spurlock, Duane Helling and Tommie Grigg. Also present were Becky Cox, Dale Runyan and Tommy Dyer, Jr. Mike Powers, Erin Oquin and Wilma Cargill were absent.

A motion to approve the November 12, 2002 meeting minutes as presented was made by Duane Helling 2nd by Glennie Spurlock. Voting yes were Glennie, Duane and Tommie.

Under Attorney's Report, Tommy Dyer, Jr. will start proceedings to collect an outstanding fire run bill owed by Micky Parson. Fire Chief, Bill Padgett, asked Attorney Dyer if he could hold off until he gathered up the 2002 outstanding bills and file them all together. Tommy Dyer, Jr. will do them all at the same time after the 1st of the year.

Tommie Grigg made a motion to approve the purchase of Christmas hams for Town employees. Duane Helling 2nd the motion. Voting yes were Glennie, Duane and Tommie.

William Hays, with Diversified Credit Management, a Broken Arrow collection agency, spoke with Board Members about collection services they could offer the Town. Mayor Grigg would like for the Town Trustees and the Town Attorney to review the material and put this item on the next agenda.

Police Chief, Les Wilmott, advised Board Members that November had been a fairly busy month. The police dept. is currently working real well with the school and Wendi Crane will be training teachers on emergency situations that may arise at school such as a shooting or severe weather, etc. This week, the last week of November, is Nationwide Seatbelt Enforcement Week. The Town is also having a lot of dog problems and he will be addressing some ordinance changes with the Town Attorney in the near future.

A motion to approve the purchase of Christmas Hams for the Inola Volunteer Firemen was made by Tommie Grigg 2nd by Duane Helling. Voting yes were Glennie, Duane and Tommie.

There were no bids turned in on the Fire Dept. Van, so the bid opening will be tabled to December 30, 2002. The mayor advised to run the ad in one time only in the Tulsa World Sunday paper and try to run it in the OML paper if possible.

Tommie Grigg made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report as presented 2nd by Duane Helling. Voting yes were Glennie, Duane and Tommie.

A motion to go into PWA was made by Tommie Grigg at 7:35 p.m. 2nd by Duane Helling. Voting yes were Glennie, Duane and Tommie.

Back in regular session at 7:45 p.m.

Tommie Grigg made a motion to approve purchase orders for payment 2nd by Duane Helling. Voting yes were Glennie, Duane and Tommie.

Mayor Grigg wanted to thank TDS and Barney Grigg for helping put up the Christmas decorations.

Duane Helling made a motion to adjourn at 7:46 p.m. 2nd by Glennie Spurlock. Voting yes were Glennie, Duane and Tommie.
