Regular Session

August 11, 2003

The Inola Town Board of Trustees met in regular session Monday evening at 7:00 p.m. August 11, 2003 in the Inola Town Hall Meeting Room. Mayor Helling called the meeting to order and answering to roll call were Jeff Coleman, Larry Grigg, Glennie Spurlock, Cheryl Charles and Duane Helling. Also present were Attorney Tommy Dyer Jr., Town Administrator Dale Runyan, Town Clerk Wilma Cargill and PWA Clerk Amy Smith.

Glennie made a motion to approve the minutes of July 28, 2003 2nd by Duane. Voting yes were Jeff, Larry, Glennie, Cheryl and Duane. A/A

In new business Attorney Dyer discussed with the board members that Charter Cable has been in contact with him concerning the contract with the town on franchise. They have been operating without a contract for quite some time. In the past there was a problem contacting Charter by phone and the service was very bad. Charter believes the phone problem has been solved. They want to know what needs to be done to correct the service. The town is aware a lot of the citizens have gone to other sources for cable. Tommy will review the contract and check on a short term agreement with an upgrade of services within the time frame.

The floor was opened for a public hearing at 7:12 p.m .concerning complaints received on unsightly properties.

The property located at 10 D St SE no action was taken on the fence line complaint, it is where seed is planted for a business. The freezer buried in the alley the city boys will take care. This item will be a zoning issue.

Duane made a motion for the weeds and trash to be cleared by the city employees at the property located at 15 B St NW 2nd by Glennie. Voting yes were Jeff, Larry, Glennie, Cheryl and Duane. A/A

The Attorney advised the clerk would need to send a notice in writing before any action could be taken.

Les advised the board he would like to start looking for a part-time dispatcher and run an ad in the Inola Newspaper for a week.

Duane made a motion to hire a part-time dispatcher for Inola Police Department at the rate of \$5.50 per hour 2nd by Jeff. Voting yes were Jeff, Larry, Glennie, Cheryl and Duane. A/A

A printout/update the town is currently paying each month. The loan with OWRB which is paid twice a year wasn't included.
