

ORDINANCE 2021-07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF INOLA, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING PART 4, CHAPTER 1 PROVIDING FOR ANIMAL REGULATIONS AND THE TOWN'S SCHEDULE OF BONDS AND FINES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the town of Inola desires to amend Part 4, Chapter 1 of the Ordinances of the Town of Inola and the Schedule of Bonds and Fines approved by Resolution 2020- ___ to increase the fines for violation of the Town's ordinance relating to animals at large.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Inola, Oklahoma as follows:

Section 1: Section 4-102 is hereby amended to add Section 4-102 (D) as follows:

SECTION 4-102 ANIMALS NOT TO BE AT LARGE.

D. Penalty: Any person violating the provisions of Section 4-102 (A) or (B) or Section 4-103 relating to animals at large, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished as follows:


- (1) First Offense- \$150.00 per animal.
- (2) Second Offense (within a 12-month period) - \$250.00 per animal.
- (3) Third Offense (within a 12-month period) - \$350.00 per animal.
- (4) Fourth Offense (within a 12-month period) - \$500.00 per animal and owner will be ordered to remove the animal from the municipal limits of the Town of Inola within thirty (30) days.

Each day an animal is at large in violation of the Town's ordinances, as herein defined, shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 2: The Town's Schedule of Bonds and Fines is hereby amended to reflect the penalties set forth in Section 4-102 (D).

For the preservation of the public, peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

PASSED and the Emergency Clause ruled upon separately AND APPROVED in regular session by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Inola, Oklahoma, this 30th day of August, 2021.
