Attorney Tommy Dyer Jr., Wilma Cargill and Treasurer Amy Smith were present.

Duane made a motion to approve the previous meeting minutes of 3-14-05 as printed 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cheryl. Voting yes were Dale, Larry, Glennie, Cheryl and Duane. A/A

Duane made a motion to advertise for a Town Administrator in the OML paper, Tulsa and Claremore Progress Sunday paper and Inola Independent Paper 2<sup>nd</sup> by Larry. Voting yes were Dale, Larry, Glennie, Cheryl and Duane. A/A

Donnie Chasteen was present with a complaint on Police Chief Wilmott and his son concerning a call on February 5, 2005. The issue was endangering the public's safety by turning loose a drunk according to Mr. Chasteen. He mentioned leadership in police department and communication problems. The mayor will find out more information on the issue and legality and contact Donnie Chasteen by phone. Dale had a citizen contact him concerning a complaint that was filed and she had no contact with the chief at this time, Les advised he hasn't had time to contact Mrs. Hass concerning the complaint. Also Jim Combs has been in contact with the mayor, county commissioner and hasn't been able to contact DOT as of now concerning closing the intersection where the wreck with the fatalities were last week. Tommy will check further into the legalities of closing the intersection.

There was no action on 322 Green Valley Road on a public hearing. Duane made a motion to schedule another 30 day hearing for the property owner for the trailer park at 120 C Street SE 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dale. Voting yes were Dale, Larry, Glennie, Cheryl and Duane. A/A

A quote from McGill Roofing was received in February for repairs on the city building roof in the amount of \$225.00. Cheryl was advised at the time that would be good for another couple of years without any major problems. In police chief's report Les advised the board of all of the progress that his department has made in solving problems and an arrest that led to other issues, the accident involving the three fatalities, also he had a letter from Rogers County Sheriff thanking his department for covering county in the loss of a deputy.

Floy Dyer was present regarding the additional street lights in Carpenter Addition. She advised that it is very dark also a dangerous curve near her home. There was some opposition at a previous meeting concerning streetlights in the addition. Cheryl advised safety should be first over preference. Poles are available in the area and one is near the location Floy is referring too. There is a pole near Charley Hancock's home but the board would like contact him to see what his view is since it would serve as the entrance light. Cheryl will do so.
