

REGULAR MEETING

TOWN OF INOLA

June 24, 2002

The Inola Town Board of Trustees met in regular session Monday evening at 7:00 p.m. June 24, 2002 in the Inola Town Hall Meeting Room. Mayor Grigg called the meeting to order and answering to roll call were Glennie Spurlock, Mike Powers, Erin Oquin, Duane Helling and Tommie Grigg. Also present Attorney Tommy Dyer Jr., Clerk Wilma Cargill, Treasurer Becky Cox and Town Administrator Dale Runyan.

Duane made a motion to approve the minutes of June 10, 2002 as presented 2nd by Erin. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

Duane wanted to know if he could mow the new cemetery land at no cost to the town. The town board members and our attorney had no problem with this matter.

The mayor advised she was in contact with Kenny Schwab with FHC, our Engineering Firm concerning flood changes in the Verdigris River and there are no problems concerning the changes requested.

Duane made a motion to approve the flood changes in the Verdigris River 2nd by Mike. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

The board was advised to proceed with the proper procedures and have the public hearing. The enforcing officer has already sent a letter to the property owner. This will be posted for a public hearing at the next meeting unless the owner has taken action to clean the property.

Duane made a motion to approve Kolker & Kolker to perform the audit for fiscal year end 2002 2nd by Erin. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

Attorney Dyer advised the lawsuit on the mobile home remains the same. He had no other comments.

Les gave an update on COPS grant & vest grant. He advised he will be meeting with the new superintendent the first of July. Also they have assisted in some drug activity in the area.

There treasurer's financial report was tabled. Becky advised Jeff would be at the next meeting to give the audit report 2001 since it is over due. There has been sickness and computer problems which has delayed the 2001 audit

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In mayors comments we are waiting for more information on the Hot Rod Club.
Reminder that all contractors need to renew their contractor's licenses effective July 1, 2002 and we are still short a vacancy on the Inola Planning Commission Board.
