

TOWN OF INOLA

REGULAR MEETING

MAY 13, 2002

The Town of Inola Board of Trustees met in regular session Monday evening at 7:00 p.m. May 13, 2002 in the town hall meeting room. Mayor Grigg called the meeting to order and answering to roll call were Glennie Spurlock, Mike Powers, Erin Oquin, Duane Helling and Tommie Grigg. Also present were Administrator Dale Runyan, Clerk Wilma Cargill and Treasurer Becky Cox.

Erin made a motion to approve the minutes of April 29, 2002 as presented 2nd by Duane. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

There was no new business from the floor.

Jack Sheridan was present representing Port 33 to expand a proposed change in the water level of the Verdigris River, making the Inola area slightly smaller. He would like for the town to provide him with a letter of approval. Mr. Sheridan was advised the matter would be turned over to Kenny Schwab with FHC, the town's engineering firm.

Erin made a motion to adopt Resolution 02-04 with the change of the date from May 1, 2002 to June 1, 2002 (lease-purchase of Fire Truck with RCB Bank) 2nd by Duane. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

The fire department tested all fire hydrants and five tested bad. Gene replaced one hydrant that sets in Roberta Conrow's yard. He would like to replace all of them but funds aren't available at this time. There was no action concerning installing new or repairing the existing fire hydrants.

The mayor asked the treasurer if funds were available for increases for the maintenance boys that received certifications for some of the licenses required. Becky advised funds are there but would like to wait until the budget is completed. The mayor wanted to keep the board's word on a promise of an increase when they received certifications. Erin made a motion to increase maintenance salaries of 5% abatement Gene Cooksey two of his certification increase will be retroactive January 1, 2002, his 3rd one retroactive April 12, 2002 a 5% increase per certification, regarding Dustin Fletcher and Cletus Harris a 5% increase retroactive January 1, 2002 2nd by Duane. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

Erin was asked to do some research concerning the judge fees, her recommendation was to increase the judge's fee from \$100.00 to \$200.00 per month. Erin made a motion to approve an increase from \$100.00 to \$200.00 per month for the judge's fee 2nd by Mike. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

There was only one bid received on the 96 Chevy Lumina. Joe Smith bid \$1,501.00.

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Duane made a motion to award the bid of \$1,501.00 to Joe Smith for the 96 Chevy Lumina 2nd by Erin. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

There was little discussion on the grant application for a full-time and part-time police officer. Les advised he only wants a full time officer. Mike made a motion to approve application of a grant for a full time officer 2nd by Duane. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

Erin made a motion to go into PWA at 7:45 p.m. 2nd by Duane. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie-----back in regular session at 7:58 p.m.

In mayor's comments Tommie reminded everyone to be sure and get a purchase order before making a purchase, the fish fry at Fleming Park Thursday May 16, at 5:30 p.m. for all city employees and be sure to remind the citizens that flowers at the cemetery should be picked up at the cemetery 10 days after Memorial Day.

Erin made a motion to approve purchase orders as initialed 2nd by Duane. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

Duane made a motion to adjourn at 8:01 p.m. 2nd by Erin. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A
