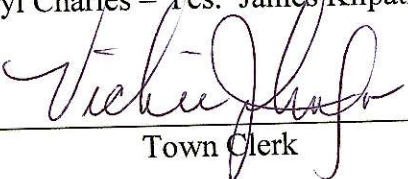
Bruce Sewell served as the mediator.
