

**Town of Inola Regular Board of Trustees Meeting
February 28, 2022**

The Inola Town Board of Trustees assembled at 6:00 p.m. on February 28th, 2022 at the City Hall located at 900 James Ct., Inola, Ok. Mayor Larry Grigg called the Town Trustee meeting to order and requested that roll be called by the Town Clerk. 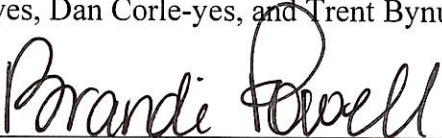
