

REGULAR MEETING

TOWN OF INOLA

April 29, 2002

The Inola Town Board of Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. April 29, 2002 in the Inola Town Hall Meeting Room. Mayor Grigg called the meeting to order and answering to roll call were Glennie Spurlock, Mike Powers, Erin Oquin, Duane Helling and Tommie Grigg. Also present Attorney Tommy Dyer Jr., Clerk Wilma Cargill, Treasurer Becky Cox and Town Administrator Dale Runyan.

Erin made a motion to approve the minutes of April 9 2002 as presented 2nd by Duane. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

There was no new business.

Dale advised the board that Becky called some other towns concerning inspection fees for contractor, journeyman and helpers and we are a little under, this occurred on the recommendation from James Freeman that our inspection fees were less than most towns. Duane made a motion to increase the inspection fees from \$25.00 to \$50.00 on residential and from \$50.00 to \$100.00 on commercial Erin. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

Duane made a motion to approve the increase of contractors license fees from \$25.00 to \$50.00, journeyman and helpers from \$10.00 to \$25.00 2nd by Mike. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

The mayor read a letter of resignation from the Municipal Judge Ron Berry who has served Inola for 18 years of service. Erin was asked to do some research prior to the meeting for a possible replacement. Bob Price was her recommendation, she also advised in the discussion of a fee increase for the newly appointed judge. This item will be on the next agenda. Erin will contact Mr. Price concerning the fee. Tommie asked the clerk to contact Ron Berry for the May 8, 2002 court date. Tommie made a motion to appoint Bob Price as the Municipal Court Judge 2nd by Erin. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

Linda Shaw spoke with Dale concerning the need for a substitute librarian when she and Connie both aren't available for work. Duane made a motion to hire a substitute librarian at \$5.50 per hour as needed 2nd by Mike. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

In attorney's report Tommy stated the fire bill collections was successful with the exception of a couple. The case with Cotton's was dismissed. The Gorman bill he will be pursued for judgment, nothing happening on the trailer house lawsuit.

Duane made a motion to hire Amanda Henderson as full-time dispatcher at \$5.50 per hour 2nd by Erin. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

Les wants to take bids on the 96 Chevy Lumina and advertise for sealed bids. Mike made a motion to advertise for sealed bids on a 96 Chevy Lumina with a minimum bid of \$1,500.00 and advertise in the Inola Independent and Claremore papers 2nd by Erin. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

Les updated the board on the activity of his department, grants, Wendi still in school and they received two cars. Duane has received a complaint on the trailer park at 2nd St SW and B Street SW that Les will look into.

The two local banks gave sealed bids for financing the lease-purchase of a fire truck.

Mike made a motion to award the bid to RCB Bank for the lease-purchase of the fire truck 2nd by Duane. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

There was no action on hiring a part-time dispatcher.

Duane made a motion to go into PWA at 7:32 p.m. 2nd by Erin. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie-----back in regular session at 8:04 p.m.

In mayor's comments Tommie thanked everyone for the help on the CDB Grant.

Erin made a motion to approve purchase orders as initialed 2nd by Duane. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

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Duane made a motion to adjourn at 8:06 p.m. 2nd by Erin. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A
