In the attorney report Tommy advised is has been unable to contact Charter Cable and he has already addressed his other comments.

There was no action to increase Officer Redden's salary retroactive from December 15, 2001 as Treasurer Becky Cox stated no one said anything to her about this increase. The mayor wanted it to be noted that she has been advise of the increase for Mark.

There was no action on the police policy manual and advised they could just revert back to the town policy on paid vacation and sick leave. Les advised he would like a maturity clause in his policies.

Les gave his report on the Cop in School Program pretty much the same, nothing is going on. He also advised of some other grants he has applied for and advised he was turned down on the one that Brad Carson was helping on.

They have written a number of tickets, made some arrest recovered some crank labs, work a burglary and invested a child abuse case.
