

**Town of Inola Regular Board of Trustees Meeting
June 13, 2022**

The Inola Town Board of Trustees assembled at 6:00 p.m. on June 13, 2022 at the Town Hall located at 900 James Ct., Inola, Ok. Mayor Larry Grigg called the Town Trustee meeting to order and requested that roll be called by the Town Clerk. Answering to roll call were Trent Bynum, Larry Grigg, Dan Corle, and Darlene Shear. 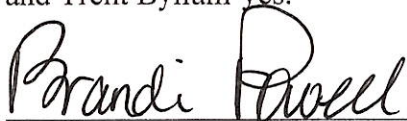
