REGULAR MEETING

September 8, 2003

In communication from the floor Stephani Freeman from the Chamber of Commerce stated that she is bringing a Red's Hot Dog Cart to town on Wednesday, September 24, 2004 from 10:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. She will also be selling circus tickets.

Discussion was made regarding giving Lester Dickson permission for street preaching and singing. Request was denied due to town ordinance against doing this in the city limits.

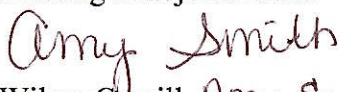
