

**Town of Inola Regular Board of Trustees Meeting  
March 10, 2025**

The Inola Town Board of Trustees assembled at 6:00 p.m. on March 10, 2025, at the Town Hall located at 900 James Ct., Inola, Ok. Mayor Dan Corle called the Town Trustee meeting to order and requested that roll be called by the Town Clerk. Answering roll call were Trent Bynum, Mark Redden, Darlene Shear and Dan Corle.
