MARCH 25, 2002

The Inola Town Board of Trustees met in regular session Monday evening at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall Meeting Room March 25, 2002. Mayor Grigg called the meeting to order and answering to roll call were Glennie Spurlock, Mike Powers, Erin Oquin, Duane Helling and Tommie Grigg. Also present were Dale Runyan, Wilma Cargill and Becky Cox. Tommy Dyer Jr. was absent.

Erin made a motion to approve the minutes of 3-11-02 with the correction of Assistant Fire Chief Roger Spurlock was present instead of Fire Chief Billie Padgett (3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph) 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

Les has been in contact with Brad Carson's office concerning a grant. The police assisted in several area raids and working on some local burglaries.

Dale received two proposals on street improvements for the use of the FEMA money.

1. Central Paving \$21,400.00
2. Miser Asphalt \$21,075.00

Dale's recommendation was Miser Asphalt.

Duane made a motion on Dale's recommendation to award the proposal to Miser Asphalt in the amount of \$21,075.00 for the street improvement contract 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

The approval of the financial statement was tabled.

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There was no action to go into executive session.

Duane made a motion to go into PWA at 7:15 p.m. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Erin. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie-----back in regular session at 7:30 p.m.

In mayor's comments Tommie reminded everyone of the OMAG dinner April 11, 2002. Trash clean up day is set for April 20<sup>th</sup>, if rain it will be the following week.

The Inola Public Works Authority met in regular session Monday, March 25, 2002. The meeting was called to order by PWA Chairman Tommie Grigg at 7:15 p.m. Members present were Glennie Spurlock, Mike Powers, Erin Oquin, Duane Helling and Tommie Grigg. Also present were Wilma Cargill, Becky Cox and Dale Runyan. Town Attorney, Tommy Dyer, Jr. was absent.

A motion to approve the March 11, 2002 meeting minutes as presented was made by Duane Helling 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike Powers. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie.

There were no communications from the floor and no new business.

Gene Cooksey was present to give the Board a maintenance update. He advised of getting a chart recorder for the sewer plant, having pumps repaired and doing work on the bathroom at Fleming Park. He is trying to install an interior that will be hard for vandals to tear up. April 20<sup>th</sup> is a statewide trash off day and the maintenance crew will be directly involved. Dale Runyan advised the ROTC class is going to clean up Fleming Park as one of their civic duty activities. Gene has scheduled his Class c water and wastewater classes and tests, all to take place during April and May. Tommie advised Gene to look into purchasing a new pump to help them while working on water breaks. Gene told Board members they also need to stock several repair clamps so they will have the size they need in the event of a water break. They are about \$200 a piece, but it is imperative that they have them on hand.

Wilma gave an update on delinquent water accounts. She presented a detailed list of late accounts. She advised board members the delinquent accounts have until April 4<sup>th</sup>, then they will be cut off.

A motion to approve the PWA purchase orders for payment was made by Erin Oquin 2<sup>nd</sup> by Duane Helling. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie.
