

**Town of Inola Regular Board of Trustees Meeting
February 10, 2025**

The Inola Town Board of Trustees assembled at 6:00 p.m. on February 10, 2025, at the Town Hall located at 900 James Ct., Inola, Ok. Mayor Dan Corle called the Town Trustee meeting to order and requested that roll be called by the Town Clerk. Answering roll call were Trent Bynum, Dean Tyler, Mark Redden, Darlene Shear and Dan Corle. Also in attendance was Town Clerk Jayce Springer, Town Treasurer April Padgett, and Town Administrator Scott Devers.

1. Approval of previous Regular meeting minutes as printed.

15. Approval of purchase orders.

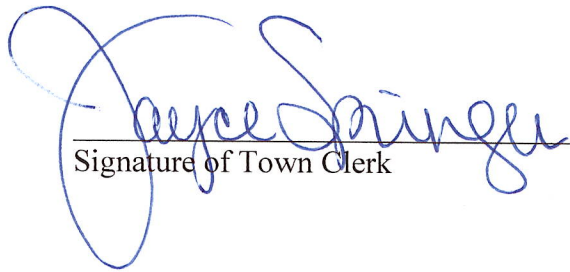

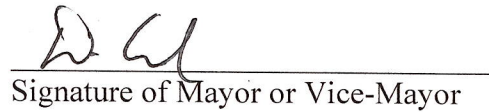
