### TOWN BOARD OF TRUSTEES REGULAR MEETING SEPTEMBER 24, 2001

The Inola Town Board of Trustees met in regular session Monday, Sept. 24, 2001. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tommie Grigg at 7:00 p.m. Members present were Glennie Spurlock, Mike Powers, Erin Oquin, Duane Helling and Tommie Grigg. Also present were Becky Cox and Dale Runyan. Wilma Cargill and Tommy Dyer, Jr. were absent.

A motion was made by Erin Oquin to approve the Sept. 10, 2001 meeting minutes as presented 2<sup>nd</sup> by Duane Helling. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie.

There were no communications from the floor and there was no new business.

Updating the Town Employee Policy Manual was tabled to the next meeting.

The item concerning appointments to the Planning Commission was tabled.

Action to appoint one member to the Board of Adjustments was also tabled to the next meeting.

Duane Helling made a motion to renew the same Health Insurance Plan with Aetna that the Town had last year (Patriot XV). Mike Powers 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie.

A motion was made by Duane Helling to award a one year cleaning contract for the Town Hall Building to Jana Williams, low bidder - \$150.00 per month. Tommie Grigg 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie.

Board Members discussed the property at 15 B St SW, owned by Gary Driver. Mike advised some blocks have been placed over some holes, but not much else has been done and it has not been mowed. Erin Oquin made a motion to authorize Tommy Dyer, Jr. to take whatever action is necessary to get the property and house cleaned up. Duane Helling 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie.

The Attorney's report was tabled.

Police Chief, Les Wilmott, gave his monthly report. He has been working on a communications grant. Wendi Crane worked a child abuse case recently and did a very good job. The police department filed charges today on the individual that was involved in the fatality car accident a couple of weeks ago. Daniel Osborn has been added as a

reserve officer. Operation Blue Talon #3, that was in effect during the Labor Day Holiday, was a big success. The accident rate for this time period dropped in our region considerably. Tommie advised Les to keep track of all vehicle repairs and costs, for review by Board Members. The Cops in School program was discussed and it was brought up that during a recent drug dog search, the school did not give Wendi Crane the opportunity to be involved in the process. Board Members are very concerned that the school is not using Wendi in the manner that the grant specified. Plans are being made to attend a School Board meeting to address this issue. Erin Oquin advised she ran into District Attorney Gene Haynes and he was extremely complimentary of the Inola Police Dept. and of what Les has accomplished since he came on board. Erin was very pleased and wanted to congratulate Les and the entire police force.

Erin Oquin made a motion to place no parking signs on the east side of E St SE recommended by Police Chief Wilmott to avoid a hazardous situation. Duane Helling 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie.

A motion to go into PWA was made at 7:32 p.m. by Erin Oquin 2<sup>nd</sup> by Duane Helling. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie.

Back in regular general session at 7:41 p.m.

A motion to approve purchase orders for payment was made by Erin Oquin 2<sup>nd</sup> by Duane Helling. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie.

Under Mayor's comments – Tommie would like to have an item on the next agenda to raise the charge for sewer taps. At the present time, a sewer tap is only \$50.00. Kenny Schwab, FHC, is checking on this.

Duane Helling made a motion to adjourn at 7:45 p.m. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike Powers. Voting yes were Glennie, Mike, Erin, Duane and Tommie.
