

**Town of Inola Regular Board of Trustees Meeting
August 14, 2023**

The Inola Town Board of Trustees assembled at 6:00 p.m. on August 14th, 2023, at the Town Hall located at 900 James Ct., Inola, Ok. Mayor Dan Corle called the Town Trustee meeting to order and requested that roll be called by the Town Clerk. 1. Approval of pervious Regular meeting minutes as printed.

20. Return from PWA at 6:48 p.m.

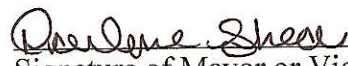
