REGULAR MEETING

The Inola Town Board of Trustees met in regular session Monday evening January 8, 2001 at 6:30 p.m. in the Town Hall Meeting Room. Mayor Grigg called the meeting to order and answering to roll call were Lonnie Chasteen, Erin Oquin, Duane Helling and Tommie Grigg, Also present were Clerk Wilma Cargill, Treasurer Becky Cox and Administrator Chris Veltema. Erin made a motion to hire Mark Redden as part-time officer at the rate of \$8.00 per hour 2nd by Duane. Voting yes were Lonnie, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

Chris made a recommendation to the board to hire John Stephens. He advised there was several applications for the position.

Duane made a motion to hire John Stephens as Park and Recreation Superintendent at \$8.50 per hour 2nd by Erin. Voting yes were Lonnie, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

Duane made a motion to go into PWA at 6:55 p.m. 2nd by Tommie. Voting yes were Lonnie, Erin, Duane and Tommie-----back in regular session at 7:17 p.m.

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In Administrator's comments Chris advised he will meet with Jon Tilley to see what money FEMA will reimburse the town from expenses that were incurred during the snow and ice storm.

Duane made a motion to approve the purchase orders 2nd by Erin. Voting yes were Lonnie, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A

Duane made a motion to adjourn at 7:21 p.m. 2nd by Lonnie. Voting yes were Lonnie, Erin, Duane and Tommie. A/A
