

**Town of Inola Regular Board of Trustees Meeting
August 29, 2022**

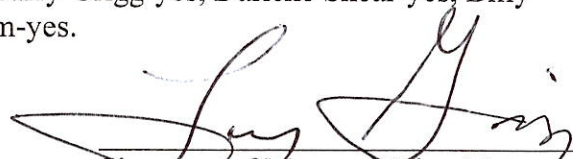
